As always, interfilm hosts not only many-faceted short film programs, but also **Eject – Midnight Movie Madness** as well as many other **events and parties**.

## Eject

Once again, audience members at the **Volksbühne** on **Friday 9th November 2007**, starting at 23:00, can pick their favorite from the strangest submissions to the interfilm Festival. For this special 10th birthday edition of Eject, we will be showing films on the secrets of extreme sneezers, sugar junkies, bloody marys and imaginary friends, as well as last wishes, pubic hair campfires and public transportation window cleaners...and of course there will be a birthday cake. Sir Henry the Organist will provide appropriate musical atmosphere, and Humpert Schnakenberger will guide us through the weirdness with aplomb.

Another highlight, the bizarre/kitsch Eject party, takes place parallel to the Eject screening, **starting at 23:00** on **Friday 9th November** at **Roter Salon**, with **DJ Alan Always** (rock, trash, pop) on the decks.



## Events at Roter Salon at Volksbühne from 6 – 11 Nov. 07

The Roter Salon at Volksbühne will serve as the **Festival Lounge** for the duration of the festival. From 6 – 11 November, festival visitors can enjoy a **colorful mix of clip-like screenings, presentations and varied deejaying and live music** each evening starting at 23:00.

**[QuickFlick](#)** on **Friday 9th November at 21:30** is one of the most exclusive screenings at the festival. QuickFlick World is a global, digital film festival that takes place once a month simultaneously in a growing number of cities all over the world. A global network of filmmakers concentrates on a certain subject and technical parameter every month, giving their imagination free creative reign. This year, interfilm presents a colorful program of current QuickFlicks and many classics from 10 cities around the world.

### DJs at Roter Salon

Following Festival Opening Night on **Tuesday, 6th Nov.**, dance to the tunes provided by **DJ Radionic** (disco, funk and pop) & **Starfish** (electro, hip-pop) for the **Opening Party**, starting at midnight in Roter Salon. DJ Radionic will play an original rare funk mix.

On **Wednesday, 7th Nov. starting at 23:00**, check out **DJ Term Disco** and his mix of Asian pop and Korean karaoke for dancing feet and singing voices. On **Thursday, 8th Nov.** following Lange Nacht des Kurzen Glücks, **DJ T-INA** will shake out a set full of swing rhythms, boogie and jazz.

After the Awards Ceremony on **Sunday 11 Nov.**, festival visitors can catch the live act **Mundoloco at 23:30**, followed by **DJ Digitalshitbox** at midnight for a real night of dancing with disco, pop and 80s hits.

All DJs lined up for the Festival Lounge are popular Berlin club DJs like DJ Radionic (6.11, midnight, resident DJ at the Bar at Karl-Marx Alle 36), DJ Term Disco (7.11., 23:00/ Rosi's), DJ Alan Always (9.11., / White Trash) and DJ Digitalshitbox (11.11, midnight / Zipper Partys)

## **interfilm - the 23rd International Short Film Festival Berlin Festival Party, 10.11.07, starts at 23:00**

*103 Club, Falckensteinstr. 47, Berlin/Kreuzberg*

Starting at 23:00, festival visitors can take the hourly shuttle service from Kino Babylon Berlin:Mitte (Rosa-Luxemburg-Str. 30) directly to the party at the 103 Club (Falckensteinstr. 47, Berlin/Kreuzberg). Visitors can rest their screen-weary eyes at the interfilm Lounge, or dance up a storm on **two floors** till the wee hours to top-notch international live acts and deejays.

The **first floor** features sweat-inducing live music somewhere between rock, electro and hip-hop by **dDamage** from Paris, and an indescribable mix of electro, dirty techno and booty bass hip-hop by international DJs like **Léonard de Léonard** and **Chris De Luca vs. Phon.o**.

The Hanak Brothers' sound is difficult to describe: a combination of rock, electro and hip-hop, simultaneously violent and melodic. During live shows, the duo develops an amazing energy,

similar to that of a well-oiled, loaded Kalashnikov.

Equally evasive is the attempt to categorize Léonard's mix of un-serious electro, acid ritornellos, 8-bit gimmicks, booty bass hip-hop and electroclash. He has worked with Peaches and Gonzales – two Berlin favorites.

This duo, formerly of Funkstörung, now work their magic together on the turntables. Their unconventional mix of intergalactic hip-hop, ghetto beats and dirty techno defies the limits of all genres.
