This year, Immaginale turns 10, and the interfilm Short Film Festival Berlin dedicates a comprehensive special program to it in celebration.

Immaginale began as an independent festival, but has been a part of interfilm for many years now, and has established itself as a festival within the festival and a well-known film platform. The program **Immaginale 1 - Children, Football and Tragedies** features eight films by young Italian directors, some of whom have received awards and whose names interfilm's audience will recognize, like Andrea Rovetta, Edo Tagliavini and Simone Massi. One new Italian talent is Matteo Rovere.

The films tell a number of little stories of day-to-day life, in which children observe our world, take their first steps, or pursue a career in football.

This program features a series of historical short documentaries by past masters like **Risi, Rossellini, Antonioni, De Seta, Maselli** and **Blasetti**.

These films were made between 1940 and 1956. During this time, the fascist regime and a law later passed in the early fifties required feature films to be preceded by short documentaries, encouraging the production of such films. Numerous famous directors therefore tried their hand at this genre.
